## Southern Nevada Health District Immunization Services Update

**LAS VEGAS** – The immunization clinic at the Southern Nevada Health District's East Las Vegas Public Health Center will return to its normal schedule beginning Monday, July 30. Immunization clinic services are Monday – Thursday, 8 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Immunization services will no longer be available on Fridays after July 27 as the health district prepares to begin its back-to-school immunization clinics at its future home, 330 S. Valley View Blvd. at Meadows Lane. Back-to-school clinics begin at 8 a.m., Wednesday, Aug. 1 at the Valley View facility; back-to-school immunizations are the only services available at the Valley View location.
