SIZE:

This facility, as proposed, will consist of approximately 40 acres. The maximum storage capacity is approximately 410,000 cubic yards. The maximum processing rate is approximately 9,625 tons per day.

OPERATIONS:

This facility is seeking a permit from Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) to operate a recycling center. A recycling center is a facility designed and operated to collect, store, or process only recyclable materials which have been separated at the source of waste generation from other solid waste and which will eventually be shipped to others who will use those materials to manufacture new products. This facility will accept aggregate materials and soil, asphalt, concrete and cement materials, and reinforcing steel (rebar). This facility will operate Monday – Friday (Saturday if needed), approximately nine hours per day. Operations will take place outdoors and there will be outside storage of recyclable materials. The facility will not be open to the public.
